Hope Marguerite 2025 | 2 Bottles

You are the first in the world to receive the pre-release of the 2025 Hope Marguerite - our 30th vintage of this iconic Chenin Blanc.

It's hard to believe that back in 1996, Niels Verburg produced our very first vintage of this barrel-fermented Chenin Blanc. At the time, there were no more than two other Chenin's on the market that had been fermented and matured in oak. Few people believed Chenin Blanc was valuable enough to justify the expense of premium barrels, which were then almost exclusively reserved for Chardonnay. The 1996 vintage spent two years in barrel, allowing that wonderfully cool growing season to express itself with remarkable elegance.

The 2025 vintage is once again a pure and beautiful expression of our two oldest Chenin vineyards. The absence of malolactic fermentation has kept the wine focused and vibrant. Aromas of melon, dried fruit, spice, and a hint of citrus zest lead onto a palate layered with baked pear, apple, and subtle bready complexity, all beautifully held together by its integrated acidity.

Hope Marguerite has always been a wine that rewards patience. During its first two to five years, it shows generous, expressive fruit. With time, those flavours gradually fold into the wine, becoming silky, polished, and wonderfully harmonious. It will comfortably reward cellaring for 10 to 15 years.

Serve with steamed kabeljou or a gently spiced chicken dish - both will beautifully elevate the fruit expression in the wine.

Kin Petit Verdot 2024 | 2 Bottles | Final Vintage

We originally planted Petit Verdot in 2001 to bring colour, freshness, and structure to our Ariane blend. This tiny half-hectare vineyard has been a fascinating variety to farm and vinify ever since. Powerful and slightly one-dimensional by nature, Petit Verdot is an exceptional blending grape, which is why you so rarely encounter it bottled on its own.

I have only released a single-varietal Petit Verdot twice before - in 2013 and again in 2016 for Kin. This 2024 vintage marks the final Petit Verdot ever produced from our farm. Dark and brooding in colour, it opens with generous aromas of black fruit layered with beautifully integrated oak. The palate is smooth and generous from the first sip, with fine tannins, bright natural acidity, and an inky depth that lingers long after the wine has left the glass.

Pair it with a beautifully marbled ribeye steak, the richness of the meat perfectly complements the wine's structure and depth.

With just over 200 bottles produced, this is truly a collector's wine. If you'd like additional bottles, please let us know while they are still available.

Cape Vintage 2021 | 2 Bottles | New Release

As we begin to edge towards spring, we're delighted to share one of our oldest and most treasured wine styles with you. We made our very first Port-style wine back in 1995. The few remaining bottles have evolved into something almost Madeira-like in character—a remarkable reminder of just how beautifully these wines age.

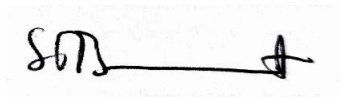
Our 2021 Cape Vintage, a blend of Pinotage and Syrah, continues that tradition. Matured in just two barrels, it opens with smoky, chocolatey aromas layered with oak and rich stewed fruit that immediately invite another sip.

The palate is silky and cool, carrying hints of menthol alongside savoury notes reminiscent of cured salami. Fine tannins and restrained sweetness create a beautifully balanced finish that lingers for minutes rather than seconds.

Pair it with a rich dark chocolate dessert. We currently have one in the deli that is absolutely delicious alongside this wine. Drink now or cellar confidently for 20 years or more.
